2025-2026 **Director** Information

1. ELIGIBILITY RULES – READ BELOW

- a. Students in a school with a music program must be sponsored by the teacher of that student's primary ensemble. If no primary ensemble for that student exists, it is up to the discretion of another music teacher in that school or a private instructor to sponsor the student.
- b. Students in schools without a music educator or home-schooled students may be sponsored by a private instructor.
- c. Sponsorship is defined as: completing the director registration form and confirming the student's musical ability.
- d. Students must be in grades 6-8 to be eligible for All Shore Intermediate Orchestra or grades 9-12 for All Shore Orchestra AND reside in Middlesex, Monmouth, or Ocean county, New Jersey.
- e. All decisions on eligibility are under the discretion of the ASODA Executive Board.
- f. Directors/sponsoring teachers <u>must be present for auditions on January 10th</u> and will receive a stipend of \$150. Failure to do so will result in the directors being disqualified from sponsoring students for the next season.
- g. Directors/sponsoring teachers must be present for the **entire duration** of auditions (anticipated 3 hours) to receive \$150 stipend.
- h. Directors/sponsoring teachers <u>must be present for either the ASO concert on</u>
 <u>February 27th or at a scheduled rehearsal.</u> Failure to do so will result in the directors being disqualified from sponsoring students for the next season.
- 2. Participating music instructors <u>DO NOT</u> need to be paid members of NAfME.
- 3. Each student must submit a separate online application and audition fee for each instrument on which he/she will be auditioning. The student registration form can be found here: http://allshoreorchestra.com/student-registration
- 4. No student will be permitted to audition unless both registration forms have been completed and registration fees paid.
- 5. Audition results will be emailed to students and directors shortly following the auditions.
- 6. A \$25 audition fee will be required to audition. Failure to pay this audition fee by the deadline will result in audition disqualification. All accepted students will also be required to pay a \$75.00 acceptance fee by the first rehearsal.

- 10. Please review the schedule with your students and remind them that they must attend every rehearsal. More than 1 missed rehearsal will result in expulsion from the orchestra.
